#### The Arrangements (Mandatory Section)

#### What arrangements are being put in place as a result of the consultation?

The arrangements in place are based on the findings from the consultation and in compliance with the Departmental Guidance.

The products that will be provided are pads, applicator tampons, non-applicator tampons and represent a reasonable choice to meet staff, su, visitors needs while on the premises.

Products will be available in a way that respects individuals' dignity, privacy and confidentiality.

The Departmental Guidance advises that products do not need to be in more than one location at each site and that the full range of products do not need provided in a single or every location.

In PBNI premises products will be obtainable reasonably easily as they will be accessible in female/disabled/unisex toilets within PBNI buildings.

In premises where there are PBNI offices in co-located sites where PBNI is not responsible for the shared toilet facilities staff have been consulted on where these products can be accessed.

Products will be checked and replenished as necessary with attention paid to expiry dates.

The free period products can be obtained whilst PBNI offices are open and are available for use when working/visiting PBNI offices.

PBNI has paid due regard to Departmental Guidance in developing the arrangements, including ensuring respecting dignity, privacy and confidentiality.

PBNI will publicise to persons the arrangements for obtaining free period products in a way that respects their dignity, privacy and confidentiality – this shall be done through posters, information on the internet (website) and Intranet and signage in toilets.

#### The Arrangements – other details (non-mandatory)

#### **Procurement Arrangements**

To commence provision of these products BSMs shall order the items from Banner. Finance shall advise of any changes to these arrangements regarding tenders, suppliers, etc and these arrangements shall be updated.

PBNI shall reduce risk of Toxic Shock Syndrome by ensuring:

- Suitable storage of products so that they don't become damaged;
- Good stock management and rotation so products (in particular tampons) do not exceed their expiry date;

#### **Environmental Impact**

- For single use products the environmental impact can be reduced through:
  - Opting for plastic free options
  - Making fewer orders per year (reducing transport emissions)
  - Providing information to product users on correct disposal of period products eg refer to Annex B sign

#### How will the SPSB publicise the availability of free products-

Signage shall be displayed in PBNI offices advising period products are available free of charge and where these can be accessed and that the products can be obtained whilst PBNI offices are open and are available for use when working/visiting PBNI offices.

Signage shall also be provided with the free period products advising to please take if needed.

# **Annex C - Toxic Shock Syndrome**

PBNI offices within Downpatrick Council

SPSBs choosing to make free tampons available on their premises should be aware of their association with Toxic Shock Syndrome (TSS). TSS is a rare but very serious illness that can develop rapidly.

Symptoms of TSS include a sudden high fever, vomiting, diarrhoea, muscle aches, a sunburn-like rash, a sore throat, dizziness and/or fainting, and a severe flu-like feeling. Not all symptoms of TSS may occur simultaneously.

In the unlikely event that symptoms of TSS occur, remove the tampon, consult a doctor urgently and inform them that a tampon has been used. If left untreated, TSS can be fatal.

The following actions will help reduce the very small risk of TSS occurring:

- At night, insert a fresh tampon before going to sleep and replace it first thing in the morning.
   Change your tampon every 4 to 8 hours or more often if needed.
- Think about switching between tampons and towels, pads/liners from time to time during your period.
- Always wash your hands before and after inserting a tampon.
- Only use tampons during menstruation. Use only one tampon at any time and ensure the removal of the last tampon once menstruation has finished.

If you decide to make tampons available in your setting, you should ensure good stock rotation, that instructions for use are available and visible, and that tampons are kept in their original packaging, for protection against damage.
