## **Request and Response**

Under Freedom of Information legislation please clarify the position for all agencies and authorities under departmental remit/funding in terms of retaining external companies to carry out work including consultants, research, law firms (excluding counsel), scoping and auditing?

Please clarify if such are required to go through tendering and procurement procedures and if there are any exceptions to this.

Also please provide a copy of any departmental or governance policy and/or approved position in this regard.

## Response

External companies will be engaged by PBNI under government procurement rules and policy, including consultants, research/law firms (excluding counsel), scoping and auditing. The value, scale and nature of the procurement/contract will define the requirements of each exercise, e.g. whether this is a quotes basis or a full tender specification in conjunction with Department of Finance CPD procurement control limits as set out under PPN 04/21 'Procurement Control Limits'. We would also note that PBNI utilise wider government shared services for legal and auditing services.
