The law which sets out PBNI's role and functions is the Probation Board (Northern Ireland) Order 1982. In addition, other legislation relating to probation activities is in the Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 1991, Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 1996, Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 2008 and the Criminal Justice (Children) (Northern Ireland) Order 1998.

PBNI policies which are relevant include the Data Protection Policy and Procedures, Adult Safeguarding Policy and Procedures, and Child Protection Policy and Procedures.
